#### MATATAG Curriculum: Time Allotment Per Subject (Kindergarten to Grade 10)

#### Purpose and Structure

The MATATAG Curriculum was introduced by the Department of Education (DepEd) to enhance the effectiveness of basic education in the Philippines. Rooted in the principles of streamlining learning content and improving learner outcomes, its structure supports holistic development while easing classroom overload. Key aspects of the curriculum include:

- **Balanced Time Allotment**: Ensures equitable distribution of instructional time across subjects, with a particular emphasis on foundational literacy, numeracy, values, and life skills.
- Integrated Programs: Includes the National Reading Program (NRP), National Music Program (NMP), and the Homeroom Guidance Program (HGP) to address critical areas of student development.
- Focus on Learner Well-being: Prioritizes values education, co-curricular engagement, and student wellness activities.
- **Teacher Collaboration and Intervention**: Allocates time for teachers to intervene, assess, and support individual learners as part of their daily schedule.
